Private Sellers with a small number of items (1-20)

You need to include a clear photograph of items you wish us to consider (up to 10 photographs). If you have a larger quantity of items or are enquiring about assistance in managing an estate, up to 10 images of items or rooms are helpful for us to identify if your items suit selling at Donnelly Auctions in the future.

Estate and large house clearances

If you have a large estate clearance that includes items of high quality or are needing to clear a full house including a large quantity of items, please call us directly on 94435367 and we can talk to you about what services we can offer.

Commission

Donnelly Auctions sells your items on a commission basis, this fee is inclusive of all photography, insurance, advertising, marketing promotion and handling costs. Our current commission is 22%+GST

What happens next?

You will receive a response to your email in 5 working days. If your items are suitable for auction, we will contact you directly to discuss how we can work with you to sell your items. Please be aware that places at auction are currently very limited and that it is likely that your items, if accepted may not necessarily appear in the next auction following acceptance.

House Visits and Appraisals

If, after viewing your initial images we may recommend that one of our valuers comes to offer a free 1 hour appraisal of your items and identify and mark in readiness your items to be delivered to Donnelly auctions. We will discuss this with you when we contact you about your items.

How do I get my items to the premises?

Items can be delivered by you directly if convenient to our auction location during designated delivery times or alternatively, we can help arrange transport, and in some instances, packing of your items if required at an hourly rate.

Reserves

Donelly Auctions in general does not offer reserves on most items. However, if an item is of exceptional value we can discuss these items individually and determine if a reserve is appropriate according to the specific piece.

Once the items reach Donelly's

Once you deliver or have your items delivered by our professional couriers to our auction complex all you will need to do is sit back and enjoy the experience.

All of our auctions are fully online and gain national interest. We catalogue, photograph and present your items professionally and attractively online and physically at the showroom for viewing in person. We also use social media such as Instagram, YouTube and Facebook to further publicise our auctions, along side traditional printed materials.

You will be given confirmation of the date of your auction that your items will appear in. Funds on auction realisation will be paid into your nominated bank account 10 working days after the sale date along with a fully itemised statement of fees and full list of prices achieved for your items.
