

Items no longer accepted by Donnelly's Auctions Online 2023

Before contacting Donnelly's Auctions please note that we do not accept the items listed below

- **Damaged items – we do not accept damaged items including items with chips, cracks and repairs**
- **No modern furniture, damaged antique furniture or old furniture in poor repair**
- **EPNS (Electroplated Silver) items unless they are large, standalone pieces in excellent condition**
- **Moulded/Pressed glass, small glass or crystal pieces, incomplete glasses sets, sherry or port glasses, dessert sets or small vases**
- **China that is modern unless of exceptional quality, china that is unmarked or not of sufficient antique or decorative interest**
- **Modern “Collectors’ Edition” display plates or partial dinner services, dinner or cake plates or mixed china of low value**
- **Modern pewter items or pewter in poor condition**
- **Non-original reproductions artworks, print reproductions or photography**
- **No china items marked “made in china”**
- **No poor-quality costume jewellery, watches or accessories**
- **Books unless collectable or leather bound in fine condition**
- **Small mixed lots of items of low value**

Lot Values - We aim for each lot entered into the auction to achieve an estimated value of \$100 or above and consequently do bundle some items with the intention to achieve that estimate.

Packing Items - Please do not overwrap. Place heavy items to the base of box/container and lighter items on top. Do not use sticky tape due to the increased time in unpacking. If items are overpacked, charges for unpacking will apply.

Consignment Value - We do not accept items “sight unseen”. Please contact Donnelly's Auctions to discuss your items and the first step of the process is to send, in one e-mail, a batch of clear photographs of your items to sell@donellyauctions.com.au after which we will contact you to discuss the suitability of the items for upcoming auctions. A minimum consignment estimated value of \$2000 is our standard starting place for accepting items.

Final Confirmation of Items - All items will be unpacked and vetted by staff prior to auctioneer's final confirmation of acceptance. Only items that have been approved prior may be sent to auction.

Items that are brought to the auction house that have not been approved in writing in advance and are sight unseen will be donated to charity and a charge may apply if extra packing or transport costs are required to remove the items.
